Sunday, May 17, 2020, Bergen Community College (BCC), 400 Paramus Road, Paramus, with trivia contests, trophies, food, and hundreds of show vehicles and visitors.

Pre-registration is now required.

Please unload and park in paved areas only, and do not drive stakes into the pavement. Canopies or tents must be weighted.

There is no unauthorized food or drink for sale; no alcohol or smoking anywhere at BCC; and no powered displays or generators except for food vendors, authorized photographer, and by special arrangement with the show chair.

No scooters or bicycles, except as needed by the handicapped. No open flames, fires, or overnight sleeping is allowed.

The show begins at 8 am and ends around 3:15 pm. Everyone must leave by 3:40 pm; market spaces must be cleaned before leaving.
